EGGstravaganza Guidelines

1. All proposed designs must be the original work of the artist.
2. The audience for EGGstravaganza is the general public of all ages. Designs should be appropriate for public display. Designs that are religious, political, or sexual in nature, which bear controversial messages, will not be considered for entry. Corporate logos or insignias will only be considered if the artist has obtained, in advance, written permission from the owner of the logo or insignia.
3. Artists can paint, sculpt, transform, or adorn the art piece to complete their design, but the structural integrity of the art piece must remain intact. Objects may be attached to the art piece, but these objects must adhere to all guidelines. The finished egg must be ready for public viewing, outdoor display, durable, and safe for individuals to touch. Objects must be attached in such a way that they cannot be removed. Designs using photos, paper, fabric or glitter glue will not be accepted.
4. The art piece **MUST** abide by size guidelines of 18"x 24" for the egg. Additional materials must not extend the size of the overall egg to more than 36"x 36".
5. Designs **MUST** be made to withstand exposure to the elements and extended outdoor display. Eggs will be displayed in the environment of strong sun, wind, and rain for three months before the sale, and must be warranted by artists for display in their proud purchaser's yards for at least five years. They must be both of a high artistic quality and extremely durable. After purchase, the buyer may contact the artist to make structural repairs for a period of five years.
6. The public will touch and experience the art pieces while they are on display. Keep durability and public safety in mind when designing. Children, in particular, are drawn to the art pieces; please keep their safety in mind. Pieces may be rejected if they are not deemed safe enough; i.e. pieces with sharp edges, pieces with removable parts that are not secured properly.
7. Artists may submit more than one design, but each design should be on a separate application form. The application form may be reproduced and enlarged. All submitted designs will become property of EGGstravaganza. Only one design will be accepted for each artist.
8. Selected artists will be given a stipend of \$100 to help cover costs. Artists will receive 50% of the auction sale price of their finished artwork.

9. Once selected, the artist is bound to the design concept submitted, and must deliver an art piece that closely follows the design concept. Any deviations will be returned to the artist for modification.
10. Egg stands are steel with a dark mill finish. Stands will be display-ready and the eggs securely mounted on the stands by the Committee after delivery of the artwork.
11. Artists are responsible for any transportation to EGGstravaganza that is required of his/her art piece.
12. Artists are responsible for all maintenance and repairs while his/her egg is on display. Pieces may require touch-up and cleaning prior to the auction. Artists are expected to be available to make the touch-ups during the weeks preceding the auction. Artists will be contacted if a touch-up is necessary.

EGGstravaganza is a fundraiser for the public art program of the Public Arts Initiative of Egg Harbor, Inc. and the Egg Harbor Business Association. Successful sale of the art pieces is not only in the best interest of EGGstravaganza, but also the artist. Pieces that sell the best are typically those that can be easily placed in an outdoor location with minimal maintenance. Artists should please keep this in mind when creating their art-piece.

Application Deadline: September 7, 2018

Artist Notification: October 1, 2018

Egg Form Pick-up: October 1-31, 2018

Art Piece Due to EGGstravaganza Deadline: May 15, 2019

EGGstravaganza Begins: May 24, 2019

The EGGstravaganza Sale: August 2019 – Exact Date to be Determined
